



## EDINBURGH COLLEGE SECONDAY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Year 10 to 12, 2025 - 2027

Edinburgh College is a co-educational college offering Early Learning through to Year 12. Our scholarship program recognises a range of student talents that are consistent with our belief in the holistic development of each student. In addition to academic development, we recognise and seek to enhance each student's spiritual, physical and social development.

Scholarships are available for students entering Year 10 in 2025 and provide up to a 50% discount on annual tuition fees until the end of Year 12.

### Edinburgh College offers scholarships in the following categories:

Academic - awarded to students who excel academically

**Leadership** - recognises students who exhibit a comprehensive range of leadership skills and utilise those skills to make a difference within the community

Creativity - affirms our belief in a Creator and recognises student's artistic and creative talents

**Service** - affirms our belief that acts of service represent a powerful means by which to aid those in need; recognises extended, personal involvement in community service

Sport - awarded in recognition of students who excel in a sporting discipline

Music - awarded to students who excel in musical performance

Science - recognises students who exhibit a natural curiosity and interest in the field of science

**Technology** - recognises students who exhibit outstanding skill in the use of technology for a productive and altruistic purpose.

### Terms and conditions of Scholarship

In order to receive the full value of a scholarship, students are required to maintain satisfactory academic progress and behaviour. This condition will be determined at a duly constituted meeting of the Edinburgh College Administration Committee. Appeals in relation to adverse determinations from the Administration Committee are to be addressed to the Principal. Scholarships are available to Australian citizens or permanent residents only. Scholarships are awarded for a three-year period and are valid until 2027.

- 2. Read the scholarship guidelines.
- 3. Complete and return the scholarship application by the due date.
- 4. Attach all relevant information, as the application will only be considered if it is complete.
