Rationale



Wearing the college uniform is a condition of enrolment at Heritage College. For the student, a uniform instils a sense of belonging and reinforces pride in appearance. Students are ambassadors who represent Heritage College within the local community, and consistency in uniform represents Heritage College at the highest possible standard.

Aims

This policy aims to achieve the following:

- To create a comprehensive statement for all uniform items;
- To provide transparency regarding uniform decisions;
- To provide clear, easy-to-understand direction on how to wear both Academic and Sports Uniform;
- To provide direction on the overall image of the college in the community.

Definition

- Academic Uniform: the assembled uniform elements for academic dress.
- Sports Uniform: the assembled uniform elements for sporting events.
- Graduand Uniform: the assembled uniform elements for graduation events.
- Formal Wear: the requirements for non-uniform formal wear for special events.
- Official Supplier: the supplier of Heritage College Uniform elements, Noone Imagewear.
- Uniform Committee: representatives selected for decisions regarding uniform.
- Uniform Stakeholders: selected to steer decisions by Uniform Committee.

Implementation

- The Uniform Policy applies during school hours, travelling to and from school, during excursions and sporting events.
- The Principal is responsible for the implementation of the Uniform Policy. Heads of School, School Coordinators, Level Leaders, Uniform Coordinators and teaching staff are to be aware of and uphold the policy.
- Parents are to uphold the policy by purchasing uniform items only from the Official Supplier
- Quality second-hand uniform items may be purchased from <u>Sustainable School Shop</u>.
- Uniform items that are not purchased from the Official Supplier do not form part of the official uniform collection and families will be notified that they are in breach of the policy and what steps can be taken to rectify.
- Students are to abide by the policy at all times.
- Garments are to be well-fitting. Tailoring may be required from time to time and it is recommended that this is carried out by the Official Supplier at a minimal cost. It is recommended this is undertaken through the holiday period as a minimum two-week turnaround applies.
- From time to time, free dress may be permitted during Free Dress Days and Camps. Students are expected to abide by the guidelines outlined below.



Academic Uniform

- Summer and Winter Academic Uniform items are specified in the Appendices.
- The academic uniform is to be clean and neatly pressed at all times. Students wearing uniform elements that are noticeably damaged, torn, pilling or discoloured will receive a written request to update the garment.
- The Summer Academic Uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4. The Winter Academic Uniform is worn during Terms 2 and 3.
- Uniforms must be worn correctly on day one of each change of season.
- Blazers are compulsory for all Years 7 12 students.
- A blend of sports and academic uniforms is not acceptable.

Sports Uniform

- Sports uniform is required for sporting events or sports-related classes.
- Failure to wear the Sports Uniform without a written explanation from parent/guardian may prevent the student from participating in Sport and Recreation classes until the uniform is remedied.
- Subsequent breaches without remedy may deem students ineligible to participate in inter-school competitions.
- A blend of sports and academic uniforms is not acceptable.

School Captains

• School Captains are expected to attend campus events in their Academic Uniform with blazers.

Formal Events and Ceremonial Days

- Throughout the year there are a number of special occasions where students will be required to wear Academic Uniform. For these occasions, please note the following:
 - **Summer events.** Blazer must be worn as a first preference (compulsory for students in Years 7 to 12). If students do not have a blazer, the college pullover in good condition may be worn.
 - Winter events. Pullover may be worn in addition to the blazer.
- Events such as Valedictory Dinner or Year Level Graduations are held at the conclusion of the academic year and have a formal dress code. Prior to the event, students must plan their outfits using the guidelines provided in Appendix C (Special Events, Photo Day and Graduation). Failure to do so may jeopardise student participation in the event.

Graduand Dress Code

• Year 12 students attend Presentation Night to receive their Year 12 award and are expected to wear the Winter Academic Uniform. Students must follow college standards for dress and appearance as set out in Appendix C (Special Events, Photo Day and Graduation) below. Students will be checked prior to the ceremony, and failure to abide by guidelines may jeopardise student participation in the event.

Uniform Committee

• A Uniform Committee is established to discuss major reviews or changes to the student uniform. Feedback and questions relating to uniform and dress standards are welcomed by emailing the uniform coordinators as follows -

• Should any change to the prescribed uniform as set out in the attached Appendices be required, a period of consultation with stakeholder groups will be undertaken. Considerations regarding durability, cost and suitability will be considerations.



• The uniform range is selected from fine quality materials in conjunction with the official uniform supplier. Any amendments will be agreed upon and approved by the Uniform Committee.

Communication

• The Uniform Policy, including details of uniform items, will be available to staff and parents via the website and SEQTA Engage. Updates will be communicated via the college newsletter and SEQTA Engage.

Breach of Uniform

- If a student is not in proper uniform in the first academic or sports period of the day, an email of explanation is required. Notifications in writing should be supplied to the Uniform Coordinator via the email addresses on Page 3.
- The college follows the PB4L model for wearing a uniform. The college has a four-step process if a breach of uniform occurs (refer to the <u>procedure for uniform breach</u>).

Exemptions

• Parents seeking exemptions to the Uniform Policy must first apply in writing to the Principal. There are no guarantees that exemptions will be granted.

Uniform Coordinators

• Uniform Coordinators are appointed to manage the non-uniform exemptions on a day to day basis. Uniform Coordinators commence their work 15 minutes before the first bell at both campuses. Students will be given a pink wrist band as an indication of the uniform exemption for the day. All exemptions are valid for the day only. Parent emails are checked for validity of reason and breach notices allocated if necessary.

Garment Care and Attention

- Academic Jumper: must be in good condition and not faded, overly pilling or failing elasticity at the waist, wrist or neck.
- Tailored Pants: cuff areas are to be neat and tidy, not torn or ragged.
- Dress and Skirt: to be worn at an appropriate length (touching the knee when standing).
- Dresses and skirts should be neatly hemmed.
- Undergarments: must not be visible. Students with visible undergarments (eg. t-shirts, skivvies, shorts under dresses) will be asked to render them invisible or remove them.
- Black, polishable leather shoes should be polished regularly and before special events.
- Accessories: short supplies of ties, hats and socks are available to purchase at Reception on campus.

Evaluation

This policy will be reviewed as part of the College's annual review cycle.

Appendix E: Events & Graduation

Ceremonial Dress for Special Events

Academic Uniform is required.

Students who attend in mixed (sports/academic) or out of uniform will not participate in special events.

All uniform items are to be clean, ironed and in good condition. Long-sleeved shirts (Winter Academic Uniform) are to be tucked in at all times.

Black school shoes are to be polished prior to all special events.

Formal Attire for Special Events

All formal attire will need approval by the coordinator of the event.

Graduation Ceremony end Term 4

All Year 12 Graduating Students

In order to maintain the integrity of the Heritage College Graduation Ceremony, all graduating students must wear the Academic shirt and tie from the Winter Uniform range, in addition to the following:

Girls are to wear the Heritage College winter skirt with navy knee-high socks/navy tights or Heritage College pants with navy knee-high socks.

Summer Academic dress is not appropriate attire for the event.

Boys are to wear the Heritage College tailored pants with grey Heritage College socks.

Shorts are not appropriate attire for the event.

All graduates are to wear black, leather, polishable school shoes in excellent condition for the event.


