Leadership Scholarship - One Year

2024, Years 9-11

About the Scholarship

- Aimed at students who are passionate about leadership and are looking for opportunities to grow their skills and understanding of leadership.
- Open for Year 9, 10 or 11 students internally and externally.
- There are three Leadership categories students can apply for:
 - Business, Spiritual or Community Service
- The scholarship includes the following financial and mentoring support;
 - \$5000 in total for one year only with a maximum of \$3000 for fees and up to \$2000 for any training, mentoring or leadership opportunities
- Applicants must present a goal of what they intend to accomplish and what personal growth they intend to achieve through the opportunities offered in this scholarship (this will be presented in a video format as part of the application form).
- Recipients must maintain an At Standard or above academic performance.

Entrepreneurial Scholarship - Two Year

2024, Year 10 & 11

About the Scholarship

- Aimed at students who are passionate about entrepreneurial studies and are looking for opportunities to grow their skills in this area.
- The scholarship includes the following financial and mentoring support;
 - \$6000 in total for two years with a maximum of \$4000 for fees (applied to Year 12 fees) and up to \$2000 for any training, mentoring or entrepreneurial opportunities that come up in discussion with your mentor.
- Students applying for this scholarship need to be enrolled in at least one business unit and are prepared to commit to participating in the Digital Boss program (<https://youngchangeagents.com/programs/digital-boss>) throughout their scholarship period.
- Applicants must present a goal of what they intend to accomplish and what personal growth they intend to achieve through the opportunities offered in this scholarship (this will be presented in a video format as part of the application form).
- Recipients must maintain an At Standard or above academic performance in their business subjects.

Academic Excellence Scholarship - One & Three Years

For students entering Years 5, 7 and VCE in 2025

About the Scholarship

- Academic Scholarships are aimed at students entering Year 5, Year 7 and Year 10.
- Open to both internal and external students .
- Scholarships are awarded based on student achievement, measured by the ACER scholarship test.
- Recipients of an NCC scholarship are required to maintain a strong academic standard and continuously display our College values through their behaviour.

Year 5 Scholarship (Primary)

For students who will be in Year 5 in 2025. A 3-year scholarship awarded to high-achieving students currently in Year 4.

Year 7 Scholarship (Level 1)

For students who will be in Year 7 in 2025. A 1-year scholarship awarded to high-achieving students currently in Year 6.

VCE Scholarship (Level 2)

For students who will be in Year 10 in 2025. A 3-year scholarship awarded to high-achieving students currently in Year 9.

Registration

Academic Scholarship registration opens approximately 15 months prior to the student's planned year of entry (i.e. if your child is applying to join NCC in 2025, scholarship registrations will open from October 2023, with the exam to be held in May 2024 - TBC). Once registrations open, the link to register will be found on the [ACER Website](#).

Please check carefully before submitting your registration to sit for a scholarship as schools may hold their examination on the same day. In this case, to be eligible for a scholarship to NCC, the student must register and sit the scholarship examination at NCC. Country and overseas candidates may elect to sit the examination at an alternative venue.



All scholarships will be awarded on the basis of the results of the testing, the most recent school report and in some cases, an interview.

Cost

A fee of \$100 for each candidate covers entry for one or more of the scholarships available.

To sit the examination at a country testing centre or overseas venue, there will be additional charges incurred. Please visit the [ACER website](#) for further details.

Results

Once results are received from ACER, interviews may be arranged with parents, the student and a school representative. Scholarship offers will be typically made within 6 weeks of getting the results.

Individual scholarship results will be sent to parents directly from ACER by the end of June.
